Application Information

This form is for undergraduate students, currently enrolled at Murdoch University, who wish to apply to transfer from an International or Domestic Fee Paying place to a Commonwealth supported place.

International students are permitted to apply for a transfer to a Commonwealth supported place on attaining Permanent Residence status, as granted by the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC). Students must present **this form, their Passport**, and an **original copy of their residency status confirmation letter**, issued by DIAC, to Student Services, Level 2, Chancellery Building. **Photocopies of DIAC documentation will not be accepted.**

Fee transfers are NOT automatic and are subject to Commonwealth supported places being available in the current course. Application assessments are based on academic merit and in competition with other students seeking advanced standing.

Students successful in their application to transfer to a Commonwealth supported place will be required to contribute to the cost of their education under the Higher Education Contribution Scheme (HECS). Information on HECS is available at www.goingtouni.gov.au. HECS Booklets and forms are also available from Student Services. The University Handbook/unit information web page, accessed from MyInfo, also has a calculation section for estimating your HECS liability for each unit.

International students who are unsuccessful in their application to transfer to a Commonwealth supported place will be offered a Domestic Fee Paying place.
