PLEASE READ THESE NOTES CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THIS FORM

- Veterinary students must be able to study full-time
- Correspondence regarding applications will be by email. Please ensure your details are correct on Myinfo
- If you are in receipt of benefits from Centrelink, it is your responsibility to advise them if you change your course
- Changing your course may affect your advanced standing, which will be reviewed by the Accreditation Officer
- Changing your course may require you to submit a new Request for Commonwealth Support (HECS-HELP or FEE-HELP) form if you are a Commonwealth supported student (not applicable for International fee-paying students). You will be advised when the transfer is processed
- **International students:** If you are an **international** student and you change your course of study, you **must** notify the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) within 14 days of the course change. As soon as your course change has been processed, please contact Murdoch International for advice regarding your student visa requirements. In most cases DIAC will only note the change of course, but in some cases they may require you to process a student visa for the new course of study – this is usually if the duration of the new course is longer, or shorter, than the previous course.

Fees

- If you are a full fee-paying student (International or Domestic but NOT Up-front Commonwealth Supported), changing your course will change your fees to the current International or Domestic fee approved for the new course.

REQUIRED INFORMATION :

APPLICATIONS WITHOUT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED

Veterinary Biology applicants - are required to supply with the application form a typed personal statement of up to 500 words to which should be attached certified transcripts of previous non-Murdoch study, curriculum vitae and references, and which should outline:

- 1 why you wish to become a Veterinarian
- 2 how you consider your past study and experience to date will assist you to succeed in the veterinary course, and as a Veterinarian. If you have any fails/late withdrawals in your post-secondary/tertiary study, you should explain the circumstances for your poor performance and why those circumstances will not apply to your Murdoch studies. You should aim to demonstrate your motivation and preparation for veterinary science.

Assessment of the application will be based on the academic standard achieved in all previous tertiary study, the personal statement, and evidence of recent veterinary and related experience. Depending whether an applicant has completed a year of tertiary study and satisfied the general science prerequisites, offers will be made directly into the veterinary course. If the science prerequisites have not been satisfied selected applicants will be given an assured progression into the veterinary course after successful completion of the science prerequisites.
